Keith Fraser Consulting was a training consultancy specialising in business development training and has been involved with several blue chip clients at strategic level. These included the Woolwich Building Society and Nortel Networks for nearly 13 years. From the end of 1998 until the middle of 2002 we were the main training contractors for Nortel Networks, writing and delivering courses and providing all internal sales, marketing, departmental charge backs and statistics.

In our first year as Nortel's training contractor we increased internal training revenues by 540% and delivered over 640 training days. Leading a team of eleven consultants Nortel assignments included extensive travel throughout Europe and Scandinavia, and locations further afield to Warsaw, Abu Dhabi, Moscow and Beijing.

In 2004 became an approved Prince2 trainer and concentrated on project management training delivering 40+ courses each year. Most recently delivered project management courses in Baku and Tehran, Prince2 courses in Kuala Lumpur, Shanghai, Dubai, Jeddah, Eindhoven, Brussels, Helsinki, Berlin, Oslo, Copenhagen, Geneva, Malta, Boston, New York, Romania (through an interpreter), Singapore, Shanghai, Lagos and Nairobi and Prince2 Agile courses in Copenhagen and New York.
